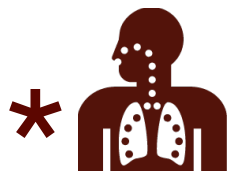
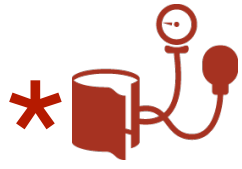


If your patient has a:

heart rate  $>140$  or  $<40$



EWS of 10 or more



is unresponsive or fighting
